The above entitled matter having been heard and regularly submitted, the Honorable Christine Nelson, Workers' Compensation Judge, now decides as follows:

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. **EE**, born on 07/06/1958, while employed during the period 08/23/2011 through 08/23/2012, as a pallet servicer, in California, by **EMPLOYER, permissibly self-insured, claims adjusted by SEDGWICK CLAIMS MANAGEMENT SERVICES**, for workers' compensation purposes, sustained injury arising out of and occurring in the course of employment to his left shoulder and claims to have sustained injury arising out of and occurring in the course of employment to his neck, nervous system, internal system and psyche.
2. It is found that the services performed by Progressive Ortho were neither reasonable nor necessary and therefore the lien of Progressive Ortho is denied in its entirety.

3. It is found that Defendant has no liability for payment of the charges for psychiatric treatment reflected in the lien of Southland Spine and Rehabilitation Medical Center.

4. It is found that Defendant has no liability for the services reflected in the lien of Southland Spine and Rehabilitation Medical Center for the outpatient surgery to Applicant's left shoulder, post-operative physical therapy, DME, CPM machine, shoulder sling and cold unit.

5. It is found that Defendant is not liable for any further payment to Southland Spine & Rehabilitation.
